The students at both Tyler ISD high schools have a friendly competition each year to help feed hungry East Texans. Students are asking the community for their help by donating non-perishable food items or funds at the school of their choice. The food and funds the students collect will benefit hungry East Texans who turn to the East Texas Food Bank's partnering food pantries, shelters, and soup kitchens for help. The school that collects the most amount of food will earn bragging rights and proudly display the traveling trophy at their school for the year.

"The Pantry Raid is a great way to spark friendly competition in the city while helping to give back to those in our community who need it most," said Robert E. Lee Student Council President Luke Bryans.

"This event is creating a legacy of giving for our young citizens.
